## Extended Day Registration Form

All full day Caedmon students are invited to participate in Caedmon's new Extended Day program. Each day, students will be given the option of participating in a **Sports & Fitness** class or creating fun projects in **Crafts & Games**. Both programs run from 3:30 – 6:00 pm every day. In addition, students from Lower Level through Upper Level will have time set aside to attend to their homework in a quiet setting.

Pre-registration is not mandatory, but it is helpful in our preparation. Drop-in attendance is always allowed, but please inform Pauline Virella or Andrew Kagan if you have not pre-registered, but your child will be attending that day.

Any child not picked up by 3:40 pm will automatically be placed in Extended Day. Families will be billed from 3:30 pm to the actual pick up time. For safety reasons, this will also occur after 10 minutes have elapsed from a scheduled pick up following an afterschool class, music lesson, or any other afterschool activity.

Fee for Extended Day is \$15/hour. This will be applied monthly against a pre-paid deposit of \$250. Drop-in attendees will be billed monthly through the business office. ## General Information

Builders, contractors, manufacturers, and artists highlight Caedmon's winter afterschool trimester. From the youngest Early Program apprentice to the experienced Upper Level artisan, every student will create and construct objects that are original, practical, and fun.

Early Program and Kindergarten students get a jump on the industry in **Junior Builders**, where students will use age-appropriate tools to do their handiwork. For those looking for something more aesthetic, students will apply acrylic paint and cloth on a canvas in **Fabric Art**.

Speaking of clothing, the program offers two fun and highly valuable classes in the garment industry. For our youngest students, we have **Beginners Sewing**. Learn the basic stitch in this class where having small fingers is a plus. In **Knitting**, students can make a wide range of adorable things, including scarves, hats, and even teddy bears.

For students who just want to play, we have a variety of sports and theater classes, including **Sports Fitness**, where the pros at E3 Sports will help you achieve your maximum sports potential. Among other great classes that will make you sweat are **Junior Tennis, Hip Hoppers, Broadway Workshop, Hockey/Golf, Bowling & More, Take A Bow, Myachi, Squash, and Swimming**.

In all, the winter program offers 38 incredible classes. The session runs from December 6th through March 4th. There is no afterschool on days when school is closed. All Block 1 classes are 3:40 – 4:40 with Block 2 following from 4:40 – 5:40. **Any student who is not at the school for 3:30 regular day dismissal, including half day Early Program or students who attend another school, must be brought to the afterschool class location by a parent or caregiver.**

The price for each class varies depending on the number of sessions and costs of operation. There are no additional expenses. As indicated in the class listing, classes are intended for particular grade levels. Please register your child accordingly. Classes will not be made up due to unforeseen cancellations.

**Registration deadline is Monday, November 29th at 6:00pm.** Please make checks payable to The Caedmon School. A \$20 late fee will be charged to anyone who enrolls after November 29th. Unless you are notified by telephone or email, consider your child automatically enrolled. **Registration cannot be accepted from families owing fees from prior terms.**
