## Extended Day Registration Form

All full day Caedmon students are invited to participate in Caedmon's new Extended Day program. Each day, students will be given the option of participating in a **Sports & Fitness** class or creating fun projects in **Crafts & Games**. Both programs run from **3:30 – 6:00 pm** every day. In addition, students from Lower Level through Upper Level will have time set aside to attend to their homework in a quiet setting.

Pre-registration is not mandatory, but it is helpful in our preparation. Drop-in attendance is always allowed, but please inform Pauline Virella or Andrew Kagan if you have not pre-registered, but your child will be attending that day.

Any child not picked up by **3:40 pm** will automatically be placed in Extended Day. Families will be billed from 3:30 pm to the actual pick up time. For safety reasons, this will also occur after 10 minutes have elapsed from a scheduled pick up following an afterschool class, music lesson, or any other afterschool activity.

Fee for Extended Day is **\$15/hour**. This will be applied monthly against a pre-paid deposit of \$250. Drop-in attendees will be billed monthly through the business office. ## General Information

By popular demand, it's been decided that **Caedmon Afterschool** provides a wonderful range of classes for children of all ages. Thanks to the community for supporting the program, this new winter term brings back most of the great classes that have been so well received in addition to a couple of new ones and a few that return after a brief absence.

This winter term brings an outstanding mix of arts, athletics, crafts, theatre and technology. Headlining the program is this fall's current sensation **Comics and Commercials**. This visual storytelling class, taught by comic book professional Pete Bregman, moves from Tuesday to Wednesday, but if the buzz is any indication, students will continue to flock there. Parents are encouraged to sign up early. Also on Wednesday is **Digital Storytelling**, taught by Ms. Vrazel. This class incorporates some of the same techniques, but uses a variety of online programs, including IMovie, where students will create and design their own original stories.

For those who just want to move, this term provides several enticing dance, movement, sports and other physical play that will build muscle, burn calories and create exciting moments for each child. On the sports front are **The Little Sluggers** and **Junior SocRoc** for the little ones and **Bowling & More, Gymnastics, Squash, Swimming, Myachi, Sports Fitness, Yoga Kidz**, and the popular martial arts selections, **Karate and Tae Kwon Do**.

Dancers have their pick of **Hip Hoppers, Take A Bow** and **Ballet Dancing** for the young ones and **Hip Hop Club** and **Broadway Workshop** for the 1st through 5th graders. Veterans of Broadway theatre return to Caedmon for the **Broadway Workshop** class where students come together to choreograph their own original piece from a popular Broadway number. For the rest of our artists and craftsmen, there is **Junior and Senior Builders, Sewing, Caedmon Chefs, The Little Artist** and many more.

In all, the afterschool program offers 34 classes certain to enhance learning and curiosity and build important developmental and social skills.

**Any student who is not at the school for 3:30 regular day dismissal, including half day Early Program or students who attend another school, must be brought to the afterschool class location by a parent or caregiver.**

The price for each class varies depending on the number of sessions and costs of operation. There are no additional expenses. As indicated in the class listing, classes are intended for particular grade levels. Please register your child accordingly. Classes will not be made up due to unforeseen cancellations.
