## General Information

Action sports, cutting-edge technology, and a range of artistic endeavors highlight this spring's afterschool program. Kids on Wheels returns to Caedmon to lead **Skateboarding** and **In-line Skating**, outdoor classes where you can show off your latest moves while learning some new ones, too.

For those with an interest in being behind the camera, we unveil **Movie Making**, the computer-based program where you get to tell the story through film, music, graphics, and various other effects. If you're thinking of becoming a pilot, learn all about flying in **Aviation Club** or **Advanced Aviators**. There's no better feeling than watching the plane you built take flight.

Students who like to move to the music have **Hip Hoppers** and **Hip Hop Dancers** to express themselves, both brought to Caedmon by The Drama Zone. If you like to create in the classroom, a series of art classes, including **The Little Artist**, **Sticks & Stones**, **Arts & Crafts**, and **Knitting** are great choices. Produce beautiful works of art while developing fine-motor skills, concentration, and patience.

A spring program would not be complete without classes dedicated to our national pastime, baseball. **The Little Slugger** and **Indoor Baseball** teach the fundamentals of baseball through skills and games. Both classes are a great lead-up to playing ball this summer. Other exciting classes this spring include **All About Dogs**, **Punk Rope**, **Girls Sports**, **our Hoppin' to Hebrew** and **Fun with French** language classes, and many more. There's truly something for everyone.

The spring term of the afterschool program runs from April 6th through June 4th, a total of nine weeks. There is no afterschool on days when school is closed. All Block 1 classes are 3:40 – 4:40 with Block 2 following from 4:40 – 5:40. The Skateboarding and In-line Skating classes are 90 minutes in length with pick up at 5:10. Friday's Swimming classes run from 3:30 – 5:30. A Caedmon teacher escorts the children to and from Asphalt Green. Pick up is back at Caedmon at 5:30.

The price for each class varies depending on the number of sessions and the costs of operation. There are no additional expenses. As indicated in the class listing, classes are intended for particular grade levels. Please register your child accordingly. Classes will not be made up due to unforeseen cancellations.

## Registration

Registration deadline is Friday, March 12th at 6:00pm. Please make checks payable to The Caedmon School. A \$20 late fee will be charged to anyone who enrolls after March 12th. Unless you are notified by telephone, consider your child automatically enrolled. Registration cannot be accepted from families owing fees from prior terms.

## Refunds

Tuition is fully refundable until the first class. A pro-rated refund of the course fee is available prior to the third class. There are no refunds after the third class.
